- **Emphasis** of the specific functions of the MRN complex in different DNA damage repair pathways under different cell conditions.

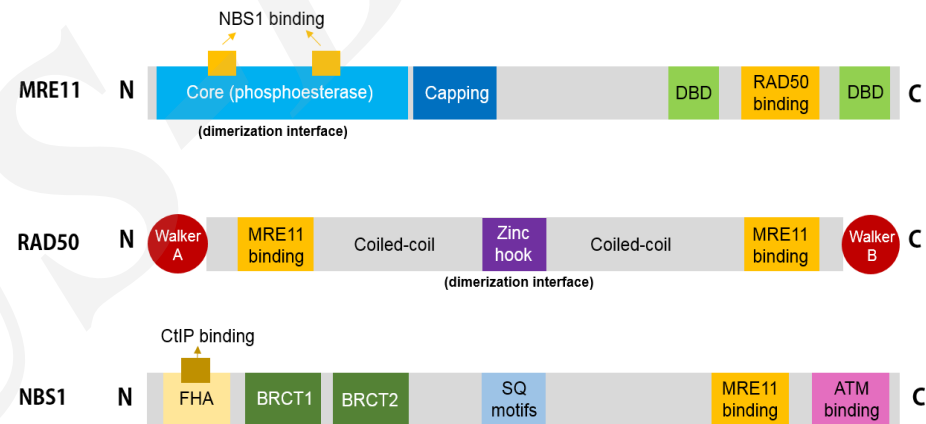
