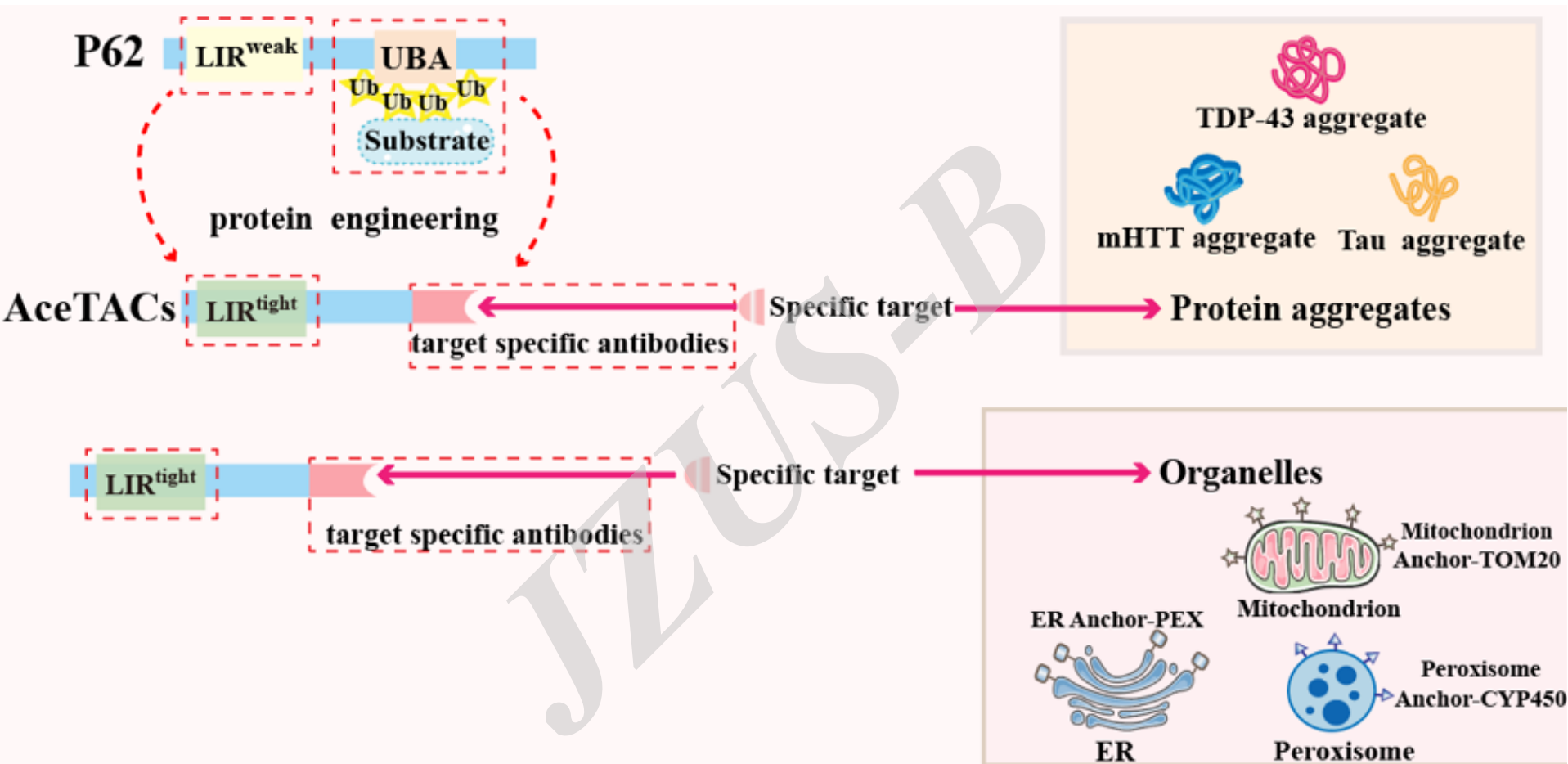


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Autophagy receptor-inspired chimeras: a novel approach to facilitate the removal of protein aggregates and organelle by autophagy degradation
