- Differential diagnosis can be assisted by CNV profiles.

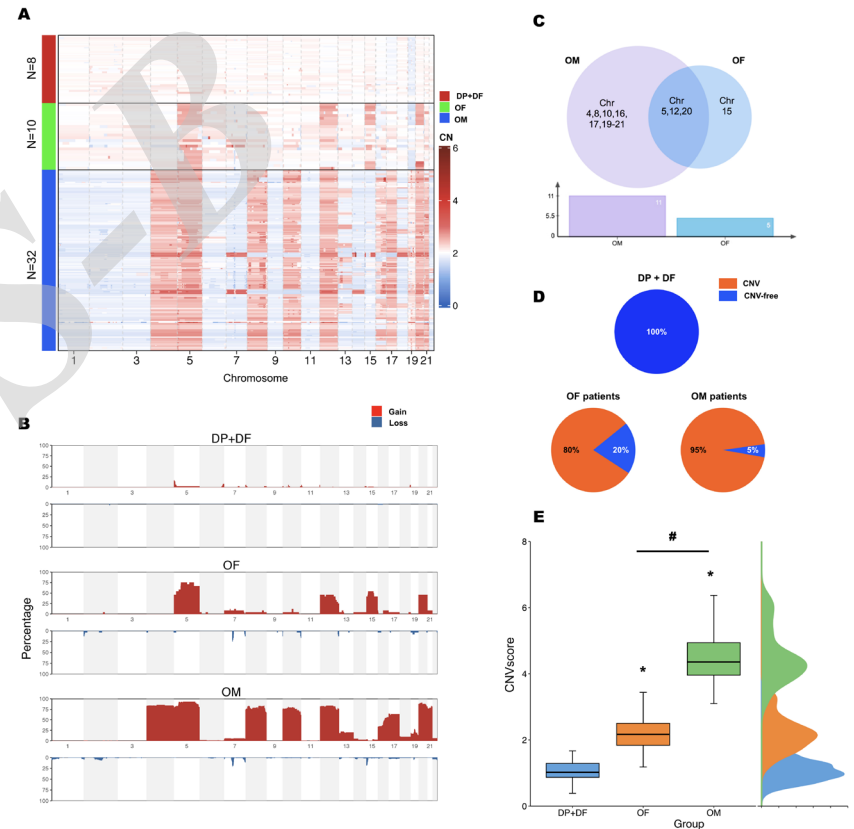
